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2012 AP Exam Registration Registration Forms Due: Friday, March 16, 2012

Exams offered for courses taught at THS

For the 2011-2012 school year, Tahoma Senior High will offer AP exams in the following subjects: **AP Biology, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Computer Science A, AP Environmental Science, AP European History, AP Human Geography, AP Literature (two separate tests administered in both Literature and Language), AP Physics, AP Psychology, AP Statistics, AP Studio Art (2D; 2D: Graphic Design; 3D; and Drawing), AP U.S. Government, and AP U.S. History.** Current students, Running Start students, and home-school students residing in Tahoma School District may take these AP exams at THS.

Exams offered for courses *not* taught at THS

Students enrolled at THS

In addition to the tests listed above, we will offer AP exams for any exam requested by *five* or more enrolled students. If four or fewer students wish to take the exam, then the AP Coordinator will check with nearby high schools to see if they are offering that exam. If the exam is being offered at a nearby school, and that school is willing to have the students test there, then the AP Coordinator will make the necessary arrangements. Students, however, will have to provide their own transportation to the testing site. If a nearby school cannot be located which is willing to accept the students, then Tahoma High will offer the exam for those students.

Students not enrolled at THS

If a student wishes to take an exam that is not being offered, then the student has two options:

- ❖ Check with nearby schools to see if the exam is being offered and whether the student would be allowed to take the exam there.
- ❖ Register for the exam through Tahoma Senior High and ask the AP Coordinator to arrange a proctor for the exam. In this case, the student will be required to pay the salary and benefits of the proctor, which is approximately \$140 for a full day for the 2011-2012 school year.

Cancelled exams

Any student who has registered for an AP exam, but cancels the exam prior to exam day, OR who does not show up for the scheduled exam, will lose the nonrefundable deposit charged by the College Board (\$13), as well as the portion of the test fee which the school retains to cover its costs (\$8). The balance of the exam fee will be returned to the student. Thus, the student would be refunded \$66 of the \$87 paid if he/she cancels after payment is made. Once a student begins an exam, no portion of the fee is refundable.

Late/rescheduled exams

Students taking late exams due to illness or **other reasons approved by the College Board** will be responsible for **any late fees** imposed by the College Board. Depending on circumstances, the student may also have to provide partial/full payment for the proctor required.
